AMTA PRESIDENT'S CORNER

he Airborne Maintenance Technician Association is about to celebrate 14 years of helping others and enjoying a lot of fellowship between friends, old and new. In early 2004 seven Airborne Maintenance Technicians got together via phone calls and a couple of conference calls and discussed the possibility of forming an association for AMTs. The founding date for the AMTA was June 26, 2004, and was approved through the State of Texas and the IRS as a 501(c)19 tax exempt organization in September 2004. This effort was started in a large part due to one of our fellow AMTs passing away. Jake Hargrove was an AMT that traveled across the country visiting as many of his friends from his Air Force days as possible. Most of us enjoyed time with Jake and Judy at one time or another over the years. Jake had a heart attack March 17, 2004 just as he was getting ready to go play golf. The point is we are getting older and many are passing away at a far too rapid rate. After almost 14 years of being a strong association the AMTA is starting to dwindle due to lack of interest by the younger generations. The average age of the AMTA members at this time is about 72. Two of the original founders have passed away. If we want the AMTA to continue and be as strong

INFORMAL AMTA 2018 REUNION

rrangements have been made for us to gather at the Holiday Inn & Suites Council Bluffs I-29 located on the banks of the Missouri River adjoining the Ameristar Casino in Council Bluffs, Iowa. This is the same hotel we enjoyed in 2012, our last gathering in this area. You can Google the hotel site for photos. See Web site address at end of article.

1. Room rate of \$92.00 +tax (tax is lower than in Omaha) per night. The normal rate would be \$129 week days and \$149 weekends during this period. There is an extra benefit of no increase in room rate for anyone that wants to check in up to 3 days before or to stay 3 days after the reunion dates of 19th through 21st September. I have a block of 25 rooms with the ability to add more. Rooms not reserved by September 1, 2018 will be released and may not be available at our group rate after that date. The motel has agreed to add more rooms after we have re-

ecoming the caretaker of a sixty foot flag pole with a ten by nineteen flag last October, I have become much more aware of flags being flown that do not comply with Public Law 103-322 regarding flag etiquette. Some of the common things are: flying a flag that is no longer presentable because it is very tattered, not adhering to half staff designated days, and flying the flag at night without proper illumination. If you notice instances of noncompliance with flag etiquette at either a business or residence, don't ignore it. Do them a favor and let them know about it. Generally, they will appreciate it, although some may not. I stopped at three businesses last week and all received my input well. The bottom line is that if they are going to fly our flag, it needs to be flown properly. There are many websites with information on flag etiquette and half staff days.

Some of them offer free notification via email for half staff days.
